Inspiration for the future

Alonzo Mourning shares his story of courage and leadership during YMCA breakfast

The YMCA of South Palm Beach County will host its largest fundraiser of the year, the 18th annual "Inspiration Breakfast."

The event will take place at 7:30 a.m. April 6 at Office Depot's Global Headquarters, 6600 N. Military Trail, Boca Raton.

Miami Heat legend Alonzo Mourning is the keynote speaker. The breakfast emcee will be Kristen Hewitt, a sideline reporter on Fox Sports Sun during Miami Heat telecasts.

"Our YMCA is excited to welcome Alonzo Mourning as our keynote speaker this year," said Richard Pollock, president and CEO of the YMCA of South Palm Beach County. "His story is one of courage, perseverance, leadership, motivation and philanthropy — themes that resonate within the Y movement. This event gives us a chance to share the impact our Y has on our community and raise funds needed to continue to provide that positive impact."

Mourning played in the NBA for 15 seasons and is most famously known for his time playing with the Miami Heat. He led his team to an NBA championship in 2006 and was the first player in Miami Heat history to get his jersey, No. 33, retired in 2009.

The purpose of the "Inspiration Breakfast" is to raise funds for the Y's financial assistance program that provides everyone, regardless of income, the ability to participate in valuable, life-changing YMCA programs.

The YMCA is a nonprofit social services organization dedicated to youth development, healthy living and social responsibility. It is a powerful association of men, women and children of all ages and from all walks of life dedicated to strengthening the foundations of community.
